

Instructor Development Protocols

Candidates applying to be AERIE Instructors must have:

- 1. Completed a written Instructor Candidate Application
- 2. Submitted all (annual) Membership Fees
- 3. Submitted a Resume indicating 5 years of verifiable operational experience appropriate to the course to be taught.
- 4. Completed an (annual) background check with no felonies or misdemeanors (excluding traffic offenses)
- 5. Have successfully completed the course to be instructed with a written Final Exam score of 85% or higher
- 6. Completed any available/required certification at the level of the course to be instructed
- 7. Proof of one of the following:
 - 3 years (full) Instructor experience accredited (by a legitimate Government Agency or approved National Training Organization (e.g. POST, CLEET, TCLEOSE, Fire Service Academy, EMS College programs, FEMA, PADI, Upper Level AHA – Not a Field or Team Training Officer or Red Cross CPR/First Aid Instructor)
 - o Completion (minimally) of a 40 hour adult education methodology course
 - o Certification from an accredited vocational school, college, or university as a teacher
 - o State, Territory or Provincial Teaching certificate
- 8. Successful participation in an Instructor Workshop specific to the course to be instructed (taught by an Instructor Trainer)
- 9. Successful completion of an apprenticeship in presenting the class to be instructed
- 10. Requirement to teach the applicable course at least once every year, or re-attend the Instructor Workshop
- 11. Upon completion of all the above requirements (including apprenticeship), and participating in one course as an Instructor, the candidate will be designated as a Course Director (and can present the course as the "Chief or "Lead").

Additionally, to be nominated as a candidate for Instructor Trainer, besides meeting all the above requirements, the Instructor must have three years of experience teaching the applicable course with a minimum of 5 courses presented as the Course Director and completion of an Instructor Trainer Workshop.
